## Modern Kannada – Conversation

**Kannada**, the Dravidian language of the South Indian state of Karnataka, is a classical Indian language and distinguished by its rich literary history. Today, Kannada is spoken by about 50 million people.

**The course** is intended for students with basic knowledge of Kannada grammar. The focus will be on the developing of speaking abilities. Furthermore, the use of contextual vocabulary and grammatical structures will be deepened and consolidated.
